LEARNING GOAL: UNDERSTAND HOW CHILDREN DEVELOP EMPATHY, HELPING, AND NOTIONS OF FAIRNESS.

#### Week 5: Do babies recognize race and gender?

LEARNING GOAL: UNDERSTAND HOW CHILDREN LEARN ABOUT SOCIAL CATEGORIES, AND HOW THIS FORMS THE ROOT OF STEREOTYPING AND DISCRIMINATION.

#### Week 6: Where do we go from here?

LEARNING GOAL: DURING AN INTERACTIVE FINAL, APPLY CLASS CONCEPTS TO DESIGNING TOYS, STORYBOOKS, AND EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION INTERVENTIONS
